E.U.B. Choir To Give Cantata

"Sing, Oh Ye Heavens", a Christmas Cantata by Helen Jun Marth, will be presented by the Chancel Choir of St. Mark's E. U. B. Church in Mount Joy, on Sunday, Dec. 23, at 7:30 p.m.
Words to the cantata are taken from the Gospel According to Saint Luke. Choral selections will be interspersed with Scripture readings by various choir members. The first chorus is "Hail, Thou Blessed", the angel's announcement to Mary, followed by "Mary Was Troubled". A tenor solo, men's chorus and mixed chorus combine to sing "Thou Hast Found Favour With God", after which the beautiful "My Soul Doth Magnify the Lord" is sung by the choir.
The men offer "And There Went Out a Decree", after which the women sing "Joseph Went to Bethlehem". "There Was No Room For Him" is sung by the choir, followed by a contralto solo, "Sleep Thou, My Son". The angel's visit to the shepherds is described in three numbers: "And There Were Shepherds Abiding"; a soprano solo, "Fear Not"; and chorus "Glory to God in the Highest".
The shepherds' decision to go to Bethlehem to see the Christ-Child is announced in the choruses "Let Us Go Unto Bethlehem"; and "Then From the Hills tops". The two final selections are "Sing, Oh Ye Heavens" and a unique arrangement of "Joy to the World".
The choir will be directed by Clifford M. Schmid, and accompanied by Donald C. Eby, organist. The pastor, Rev. C. E. Ulrich, will assist in the devotional part of the program.
