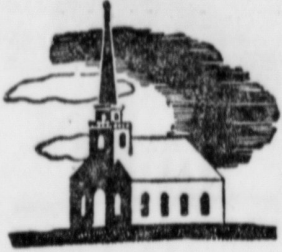

It's strange how a man's mind works . . .

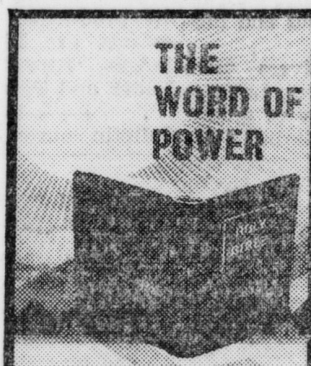

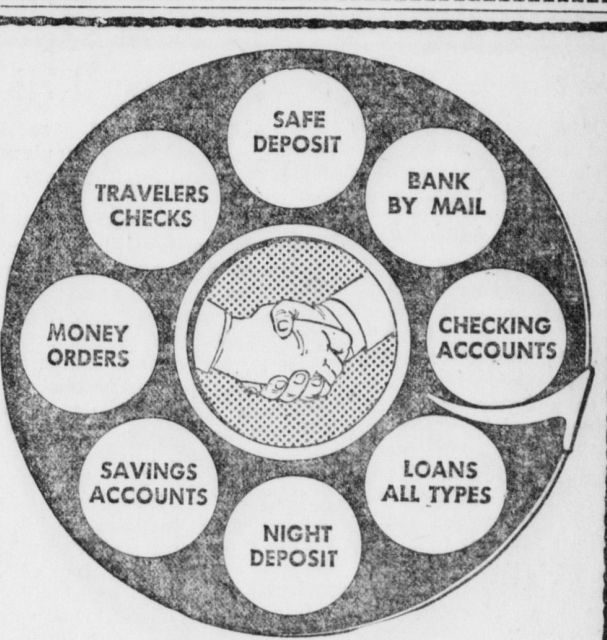
