# Suicide

A verdict of suicide by strychnine poisoning was issued last week in the June 8 death of the former treasurer of Mount Joy sportsmens' association, Horace Wertz.

Dr. Gilbert N. Clime, county coroner, said laboratory tests showed that he died of poisoning.

He ruled it was suicide.

Wertz died June 6 after being stricken ill at home. Unable to pinpoint the death cause, Dr. Clime ordered a laboratory examination.

He said last week that an FBI report showed Wertz had suffered poisoning.

Dr. Clime said strychine is "very toxic" and a dose the size of a green pea would be sufficient to cause death.

He said it isn't known where Wertz obtained the poison but pointed out that it is used in certain insect poisons. Wertz, as an active sportsman, was probably a-ware of the strychnine content of certain pesticides, Dr. Clime said, and "in all likelihood obtained it in that fashion."


