3 tablespoons butter or margarine
3 tablespoons flour
2 cups milk
3 hard-cooked eggs, finely chopped
2 teaspoons salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
1/8 teaspoon nutmeg
2 cups corn flakes or 1/2 cup corn flake crumbs
1/2 cup grated Cheddar cheese
2 tablespoons butter or margarine, melted
Paprika
Cook spinach according to directions on carton; drain thoroughly. Cook onions in butter until transparent. Stir in flour. Add milk gradually, stirring constantly.
