Combine pineapple (with syrup from can), molasses, and butter in saucepan. Bring to a boil; simmer five minutes. Add rum flavoring. Serve hot or cold over ice cream. Makes 1½ cups of sauce.

Special Chocolate Sauce

1 cup (6-ounces) semi-sweet chocolate pieces
½ cup whipping cream
½ teaspoon vanilla
In saucepan over low heat, heat together chocolate and cream until chocolate melts; stir in vanilla. Cool. Makes 1 cup.

Mallow-Mint Sauce

2 tablespoons cream
1 cup marshmallow cream
¼ cup (four 4-in. sticks) crushed peppermint stick candy

Stir cream into marshmallow until smooth. Reserve 1 tablespoon candy for garnish; stir remaining into marshmallow. Serve on chocolate or vanilla ice cream; garnish with crushed candy. Makes about 1 cup.

Fresh Orange Nut Sundaes

3 medium oranges, peeled, cut into bite-size pieces
3 to 4 tablespoons white corn syrup
1½ pints vanilla ice cream
Whipped topping
2 tablespoons chopped pecans or walnuts
Combine orange pieces and corn syrup; set aside for flavors to blend. Place a scoop (½ cup) ice cream in each sundae dish. Spoon oranges with juice over ice cream. Top each sundae with whipped topping; sprinkle with nuts. Serve at once.

Pineapple Sauce

1 tablespoon cornstarch
Dash of salt
1½ cups pineapple juice
1 teaspoon lemon juice
¼ cup drained crushed pineapple
Blend cornstarch and salt in saucepan and add pineapple

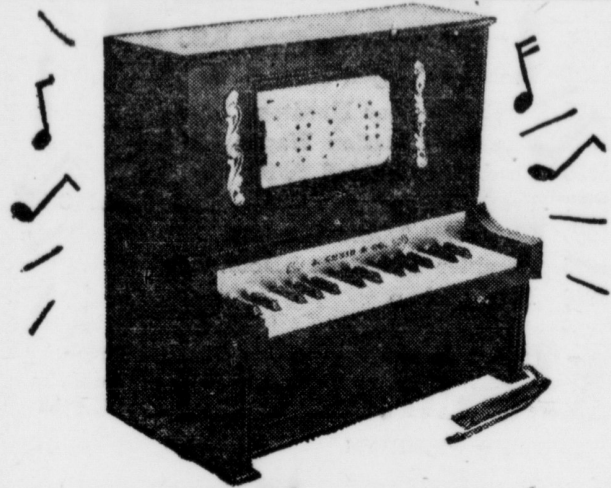
