Furthermore, says the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture, farmers are expected to be even better customers. Their gross income in 1961, after all totals are in, is expected to be about \$1½ billion more than in 1960.

Equipment and machinery purchases may be from \$100 million to \$150 million higher. Farmers will spend more for other production items—fuel, oil and other petroleum products, pesticides, fertilizer, and containers.
