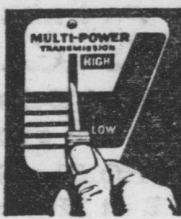
The Hempfield Sertoma club met Wednesday evening April 8 at 6:30 p.m. at the Mount Joy American Legion Post Home.

The guests for the evening were the Girl Scout Troop of East Petersburg, which the club sponsors. The speaker was Dr. S. June Smith.

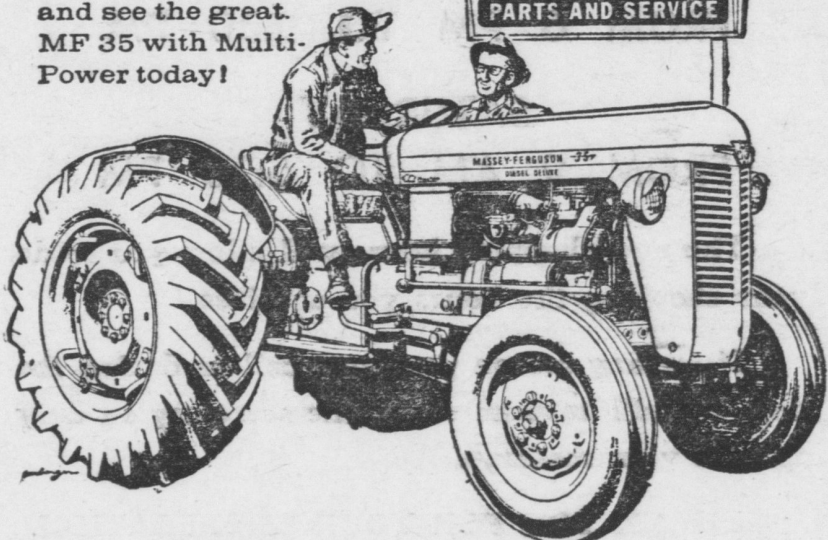

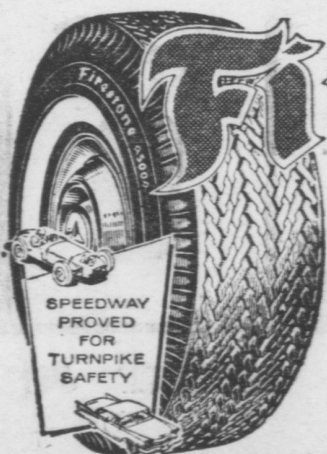

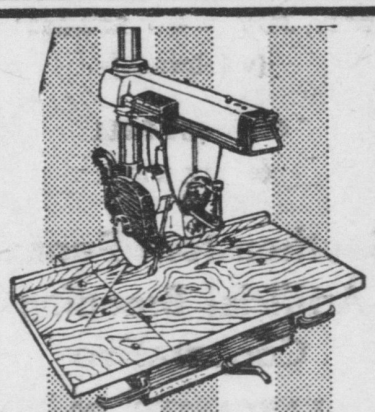
