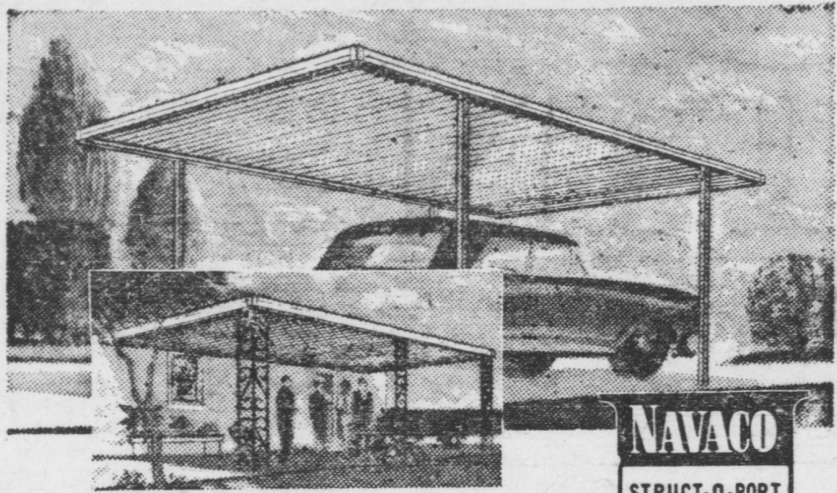

**Different Hobby
-- All By Mail**

"Are you tired of collecting stamps? Postcards? Old coins? Do you want to have something as a hobby that your friends do not?"

Well, frankly, the old hobbies we've had for years are

good enough for us. But on the chance that some of our readers are a bit jaded, and would like to try something different, we offer some more of the proposal that came to us from Alan W. Farrant.

"With the help of the United States Post Office," he writes, "You can have fun collecting mail from unusual towns—places with names your friends won't know.

"If you are interested in sports, mail will be fun to get from Ball Club, Arkansas; Bruin, Kentucky; or from eleven of the towns named Derby, none of which is in Kentucky.

"Actually, it is not the mail itself you want, but the town's cancellation mark on the envelope. You can save envelope, but most hobbyists cut out the cancellations and stick them in a snapshot album.

"Getting these cancelled envelopes is not as difficult as you might think. The easiest method is to fix a stamp-

ed envelope addressed to yourself. Put it unsealed, into an envelope addressed to the postmaster of the town concerned. Enclose a short note, to this effect:

"Postmaster:
'I am collecting town cancellations on envelopes. Please have the enclosed canceled plainly and mail it to me. Thank you.'

"Both envelopes must have first-class postage. You will find almost all of the post offices will cooperate with you. Mr. Farrant suggests specializing, viz: "Everyone likes

money. So a good collection of names would be: Dollar Bay, Michigan; Coin, Iowa; Dinero, Texas; Dime Box, Texas; Deposit, New York; Cash, Arkansas; Cost, Texas; Cashiers, North Carolina; and Cashtown, Penna. Perhaps you'd better skip Cheapside, Texas . . .

"Other towns with appealing names include Darling, Miss.; Daylight, Tennessee; Delight, Arkansas; Midnight, Mississippi; Mistletoe, Kentucky; Morning Sun, Iowa; Rising Fawn, Ga.; Ten Sleep, Wyoming; Pie, West Virginia;

Welcome, Louisiana; and City of Industry, California." Don't try foreign cities, though, he warns. For one thing, you haven't any stamps to put on your self-addressed envelopes. Instead of Cairo, Egypt, you'll have to be happy with Cairo, Illinois (or Georgia, Missouri, Nebraska, New York, Ohio, or West Virginia). Which is perhaps just as lucky for the postmaster by the Pyramids. —Selected
