north by Route 241 and on the south by Route 441.

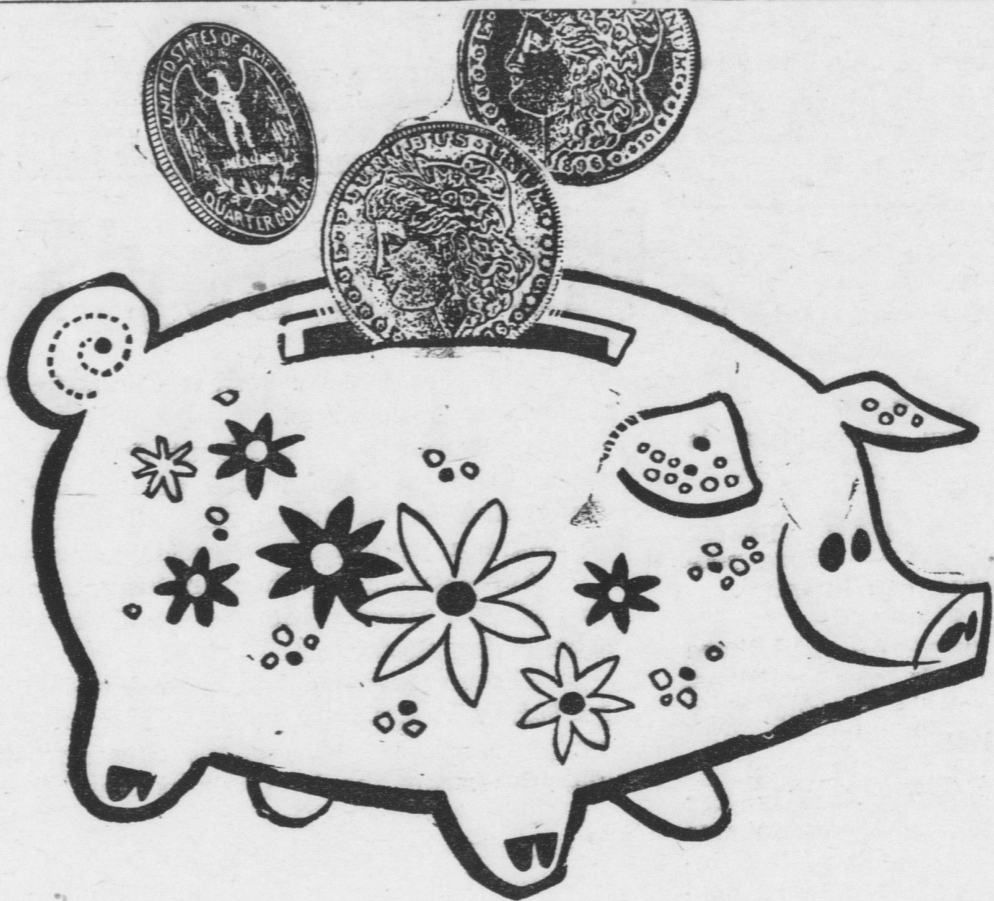
