 flour. Brown lamb in hot shortening or oil in large saucepan. Add water to lamb. Cover and simmer gently for 20 minutes. Stir in carrots and cook 10 minutes longer. Meanwhile, prepare pastry through step of rolling out top crust and cutting the steam vents. Make smooth paste with seasoned flour

and about 3 tablespoons lamb stock. Stir into the lamb - carrot mixture. Bring mixture to boiling and cook until thickened. Stir in onions and green beans and bring to boiling. Pour into pastry - lined

pie pan. Arrange top pastry over filling. Trim, turn under and flute edge. Bake in hot oven (425 degrees) 45 to 50 minutes or until pastry is lightly browned. Serve immediately. Makes 6 servings.
