**Tractor Fires Very Expensive**

The cost of a tractor fire in the field can be much more than the value of damaged or destroyed equipment.

Workers may be injured, the crop destroyed, and time lost while waiting for equipment to be repaired or replaced.

According to the National Safety Council, seven typical causes of farm equipment fires are:

1. Fuel leaks;
2. Electrical shorts;
3. Accumulation of trash, dust or chaff;
4. Broken or cracked sediment bulbs;
5. Malfunctioning carburetors;
6. Exhaust sparks;
7. Careless practice such as smoking or refueling hot engines.

Tractors and other farm power equipment can easily be equipped with fire extinguishers — and they should be, says the Council.

Generally, the best extinguisher is the multipurpose dry chemical type, suitable for use on any kind of farm fire. Size depends on the size and type of equipment and the kind of farming done. However, the unit should contain at least 10 pounds of chemical.

The extinguisher should be mounted where it can be easily reached from both the operator's platform and the ground. The best location depends on the make and model of machine and different combinations of mounted equipment used.

Farming is one of the few industries where accidents to non-workers, such as small children, must be included in work statistics. On the farm, safety is truly a family affair.

**Read the Bedding Labels**

Foams and fiber-fills are not all there is to the bedding and upholstered furniture business, says Helen E. Bell, extension home management specialist of the Penn State University. The story is bigger than many of us realize.

Special formulas and chemical additives applied to many of the fillings are im-

portant in themselves, she points out. Chemical additives may supply an essential family health protection or they may provide greater ease of surface care.

When you shop for bedding, look for that which is labeled "treated with bacterio-static chemicals developed to retard infectious germs, mold, mildew, fungi, and odor-causing bacteria." These health-protecting chemicals are becoming a must for hospital bedding.

Watch for tags that state dual-sleep pieces and upholstered pieces have been treated with chemicals which guard against soil and spillage penetrating deep into upholstery covers, Miss Bell advises. This chemical treatment means that surface soil can be wiped off and the upholstery has a longer life of clean appearance than untreated upholstery.

Labels on bedding and upholstered pieces should state the exact filling content. Labels are for your information and protection so be sure to read them to know what you are buying.

**Plant Rose Tree For Distinction**

If you wish to attract special attention to any particularly pleasing part of your property, or to dress up and dignify an obscure corner, plant tree roses, says the American Assoc. of Nurserymen. Tree roses are the most stately of all. Even planted in the midst of your rose or other garden they will attract the eye immediately.

What is a tree rose? It is, in effect, a small tree trunk usually three to four feet in height with what looks like a lovely bouquet of roses growing at the top. The kind of flowers may be hybrid tea, floribunda, grandiflora or climber. The kind of flowers is determined by the type which the grower "buds" to the trunk.

Tree roses are wonderful accent plants because of the sharp contrast between the trunk and the flowers, which sometimes seem to be beautiful bouquet of roses suspended in space, depending on how and where the plant is set out. Tree roses in pots or tubs especially do marvels in beautifying a garden patio, porch or any other area used for dining and entertainment. They probably will cause more comments from guests than almost any other flowers. Tree roses usually are available only from nurserymen, including quality garden centers.

**USE PESTICIDES SAFELY**

Read the label before you buy a pesticide, advise Penn State extension specialists. Make sure the label gives the name of the pest you want to kill. After you buy a pesticide, read the label again before using. Then follow all label directions and precautions for storing, mixing, and applying the pesticide, and for disposing of unused material or the empty container.
