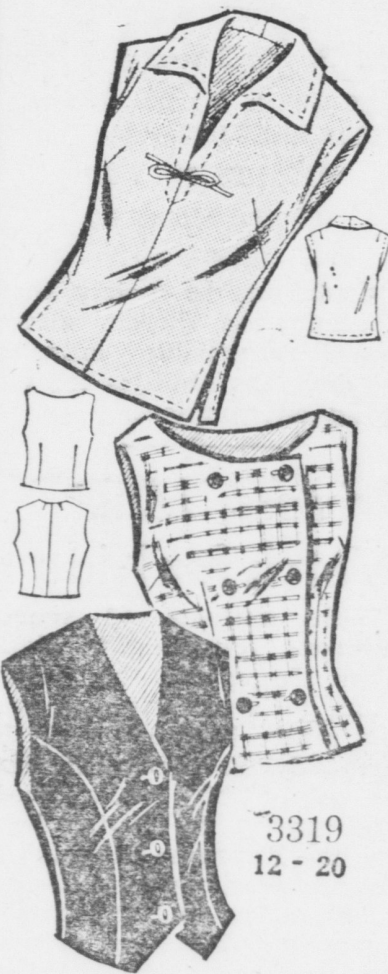
THE UNCOMMON MAN
