Instead of packing away these items in drawers, frame them and hang up your memories on your walls.

As a starter use snapshots taken on the trip and frame them in the maps of areas you visited.

Any travel agent or tourist information service will be plored in the United States.

First, select the pictures you want to frame. Trim the borders of each snapshot carefully and try them out for effectiveness on the map. Frames from the dimestore will look almost like customframing if you do the matting skillfully.

Glue the prints with rubber cement to the map; then, glue the maps to cardboard cut to fit the frame.

If one photograph is especially good, you might want to consider having it enlarged and frame it alone. Or, if you have enough wall space, you can frame additional snapshots, arranged in the order of the places you visited.
