### Pre Registration In Manheim Dist.

Pre School Testing Program for elementary children in the Manheim Central school district, will be held on April 6 and 8.

The dates and time are listed below: (mornings only)  
Elm Tree, Mastersonville, Manheim, and Fairland, April 6;

Sporting Hill, and White Oak, April 8.

Parents will be notified by letter, regarding the time and school for this enrollment. Parents who have not received their letters by April 1, are asked to notify the elementary supervisor (Ph. 665-200) or the school in their area.

Birth and vaccination certificates should be presented at the time of registration. To enter first grade in September, 1965, the child must be 6 years of age on or before January 31, 1966.

Children who are currently attending kindergarten classes in the district have been given the pre-school test and will not report for classes during this enrollment period.

Registration for kindergarten in the Manheim Central school district for the 1965-1966 school term will be held on April 28, 1965.

### SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

A child who buys his lunch in a school participating in the National School Lunch Program is assured this meal will provide him at least one-third of his daily nutritional needs, according to a U. S. Dept. of Agriculture report.

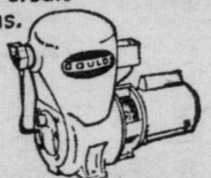
