Tempting Vegetable Ways

cabbage

Besides a variety of fresh vegetables now available the year round, you usually have the choice of buying other margarine forms - canned, frozen, or dehydrated. It is up to you to make the choice - one that suits your taste as well as your budget.

BEETS WITH ORANGE SAUCE

1/4 cup sugar

³/₄ teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons cornstarch

³/₄ cup orange juice 2 tablespoons lemon juice ³/₄ teaspoon grated orange

rind

1 tablespoon butter or margarine

23/4 cups beets, cooked or canned, sliced drained

Combine sugar, salt, and cornstarch; mix well. Stir in orange juice. Cook 'till thickened, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Stir in lemon juice; orange rind, and fat. Pour sauce over beets and stir carefully. Heat and serve. Makes 6 servings.

2 tablespoons butter or 1/4 cup flour

1 cup boiling water

2 cups whole or skim milk 2 cups ham, cooked and diced


1/4 cup breadcrumbs, fine dry

1 tablespoon butter or melted

Cook cabbage in boiling water, covered, 8 to 10 minutes, or until tender. Drain thoroughly. Melt fat and blend in flour. Stir in milk slowly. Cook until thickened, stirring constantly. Add cabbage and ham to sauce and cook slowly until heated thorough. Mix breadcrumbs with fat & heat until crumbs are lightly browned. Top cabbage and ham with the crumbs just before serving. Makes 6 servings.

APPLE-GLAZED SWEET POTATOES

BAKED LIMA BEANS IN 1/2 cup apple jelly Scotland School. SOUR CREAM 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon Melt apple jelly in a fry 1½ teaspoons brown sugar, pan over low heat. Stir in cinnamon and salt. Add the sweetpotatoes.
