But in standing here and wondering so, I feel like I've been near God.

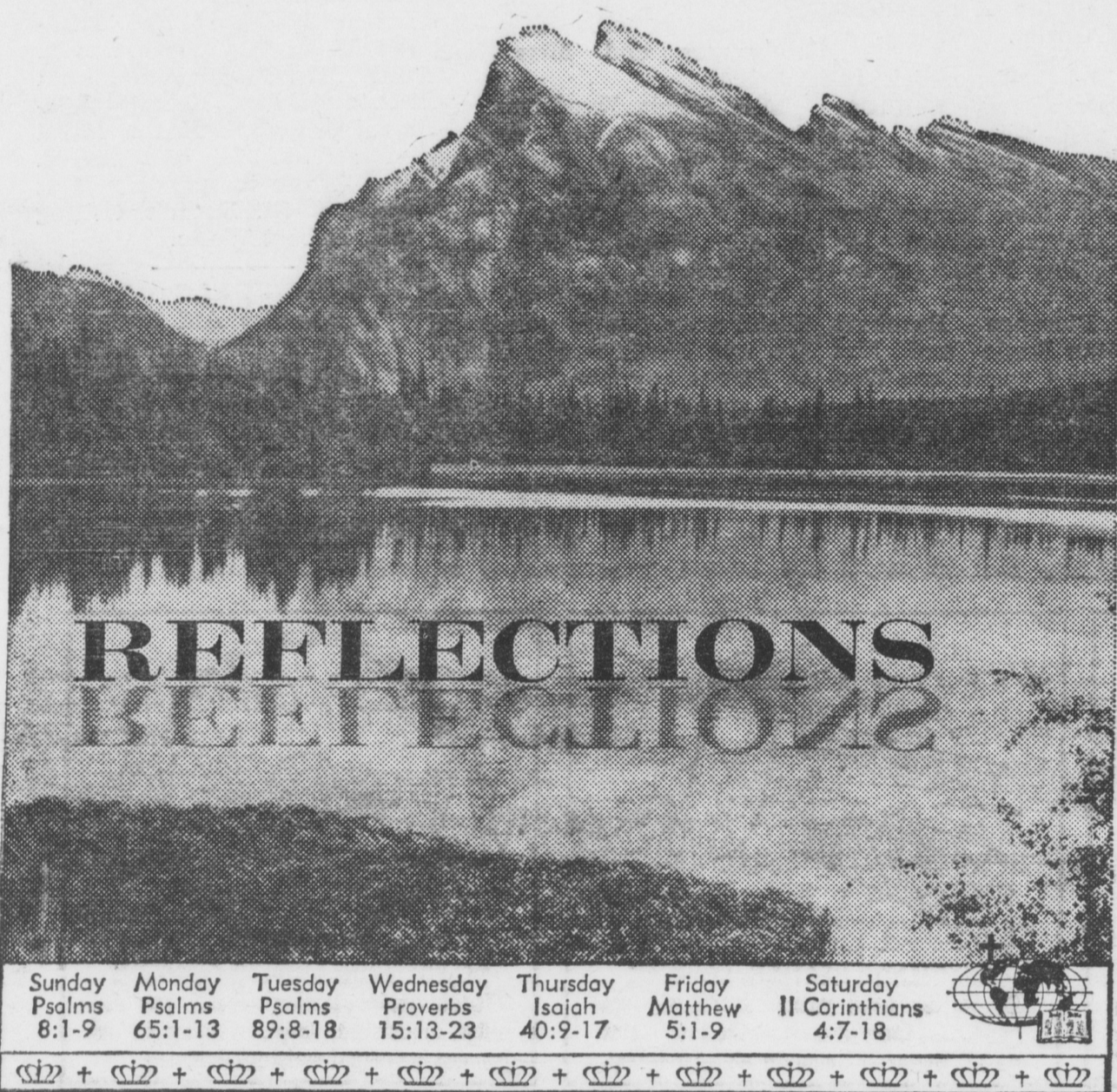
There is a place where I can find Him always—in Church. Will you come with me?
