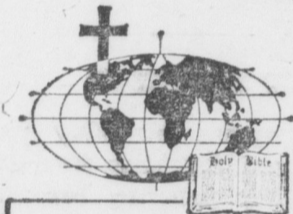
Church is one place where this lesson can be learned. In God's House, we know instinctively how small we really are, which makes us more thankful for both His love and compassion.
