TAX ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF MOUNT
JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, IM-
POSING TAXES AND FIX-
ING THE TAX RATE FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR 1967.
IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED
BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY
LANCASTER COUNTY, PA.
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A tax is hereby
levied on all property and
occupations within the said
Borough subject to taxation
for Borough purposes for the
fiscal year 1967 as follows:

Tax rate for general pur-
poses, the sum of twelve
(12) mills on each dollar of
assessed valuation:

Making a total tax rate for
all Borough Purposes under
this section, of twelve (12)
mills.

Section 2. In addition to
the taxes levied by Section 1
of this Ordinance, a per cap-
ita tax of \$5.00 is hereby
levied on each resident of
the Borough over twenty-one
years of age, for the fiscal
year 1967. This Section is
enacted under authority of
the Act of June 25, 1947, P.
L. 1145 and its amendments.

Section 3. All ordinances
and parts of ordinances in-
consistent with this ordin-
ance are hereby repealed to
the extent of such inconsis-
tency.
