Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 28. There will be a service of Holy Communion on that day at 7 a.m. That evening there will be a service of Litany, Penitential Office and Holy Communion at 7 p.m.

Each Tuesday at 7 a.m. there will be a celebration of the Holy Communion followed by a light breakfast served at a nominal fee. There will be a second weekly service of Holy Communion each Thursday at 7 p.m. Every Sunday in March beginning with March 3 at 7 p.m. there will be a service of Evening Prayer followed by a discussion led by Dr.

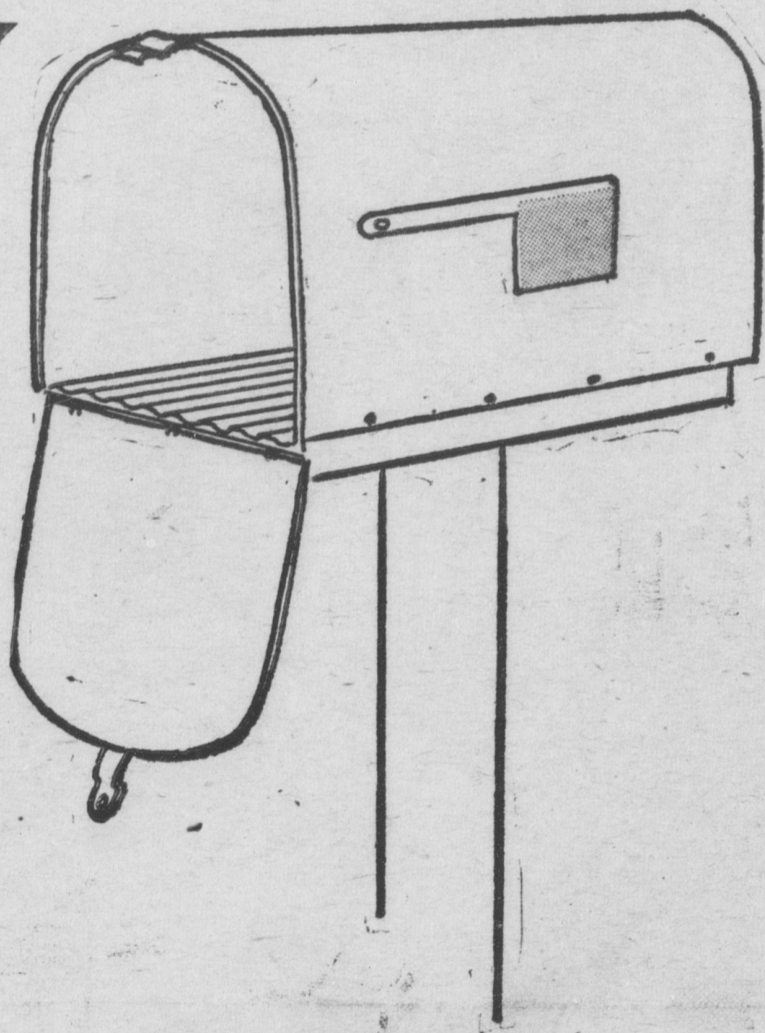
