TAX ORDINANCE
AN ORDINANCE OF MOUNT JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IMPOSING TAXES AND FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1969.
IT IS HEREBY OBTAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY, PA. AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1. A tax is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1969 as follows:
Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of fifteen (15) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. Making a total tax rate for the Borough purposes under this section of fifteen (15) mills.
SECTION 2. In addition to the taxes levied by Section 1 of this ordinance, a per capita tax of \$5.00 is hereby levied on each resident of the Borough over twenty-one years of age for the fiscal year 1969. This Section is enacted under authority of the Act of June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145 and its amendments.
SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
