Votech School Quotas Assigned

Final quotas of assignments to the Votech schools have been made and Donegal district has been given 91 places for next fall.

The local district will send 2 to Brownstown school, 13 to Willow Street and 76 to the Mount Joy school north of the borough.

Students who want courses which are not available at Mount Joy are transferred to one of the other two centers in the county and other boys and girls in other sections who want courses given only here will be moved into this center.

Some of the vocational and technical classes will be given at all three centers, but there are several which will be given at only one (or possibly two) schools.

Do not use a blowtorch to thaw frozen pipes. Rapid thawing may cause pipes to burst. Heat them slowly, using a hair dryer, heat lamp, heating cable or light bulbs. Move the heat along the pipe, working near the faucet, which is kept open to allow water to flow out as ice melts.

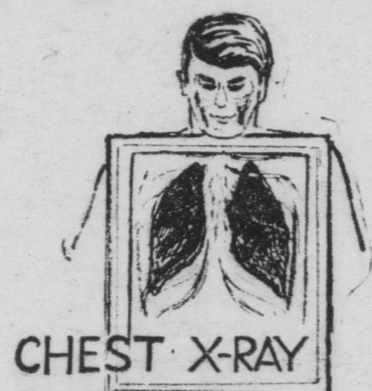
