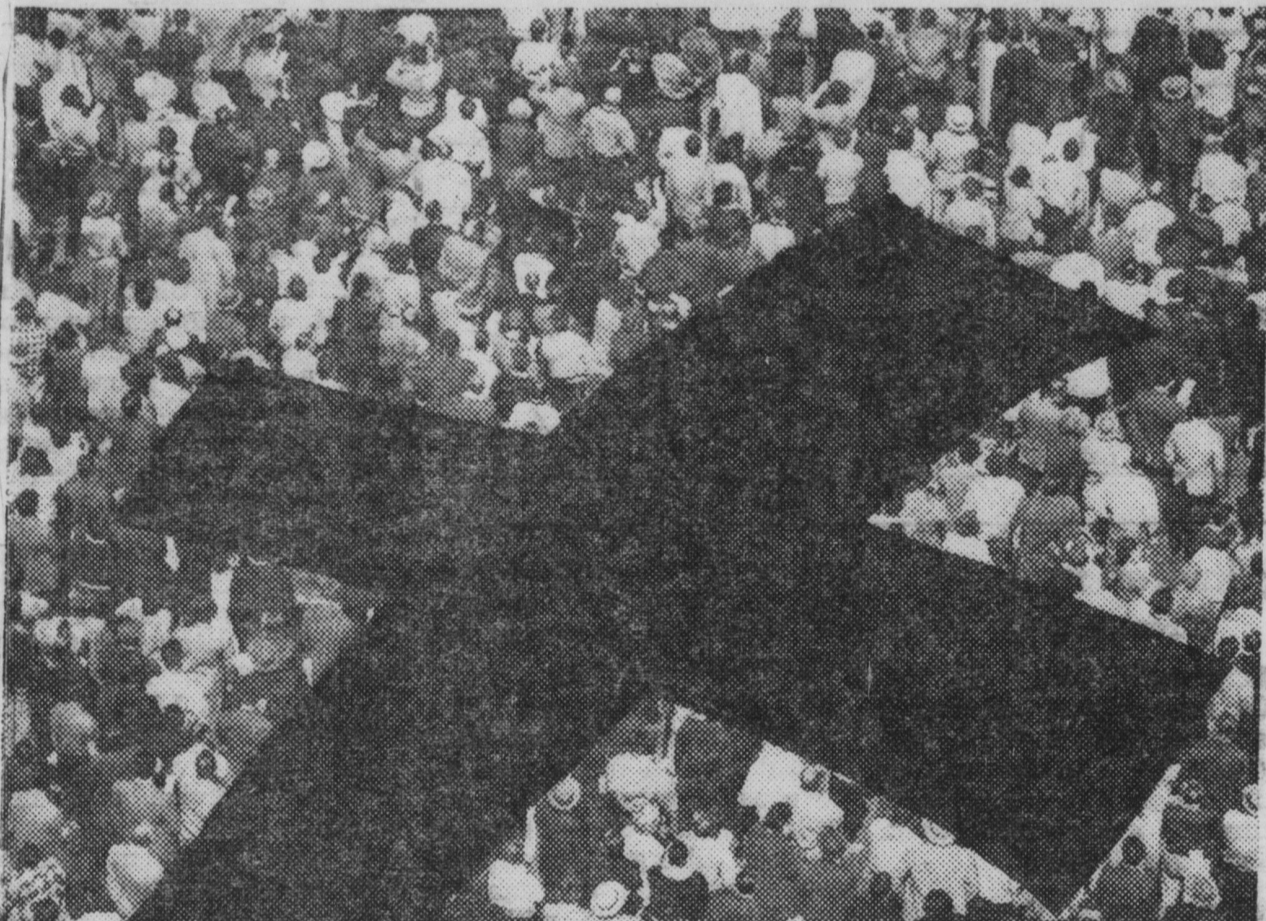


# GO TO Church on Sunday
