## JIM WAS GRADUATED TODAY

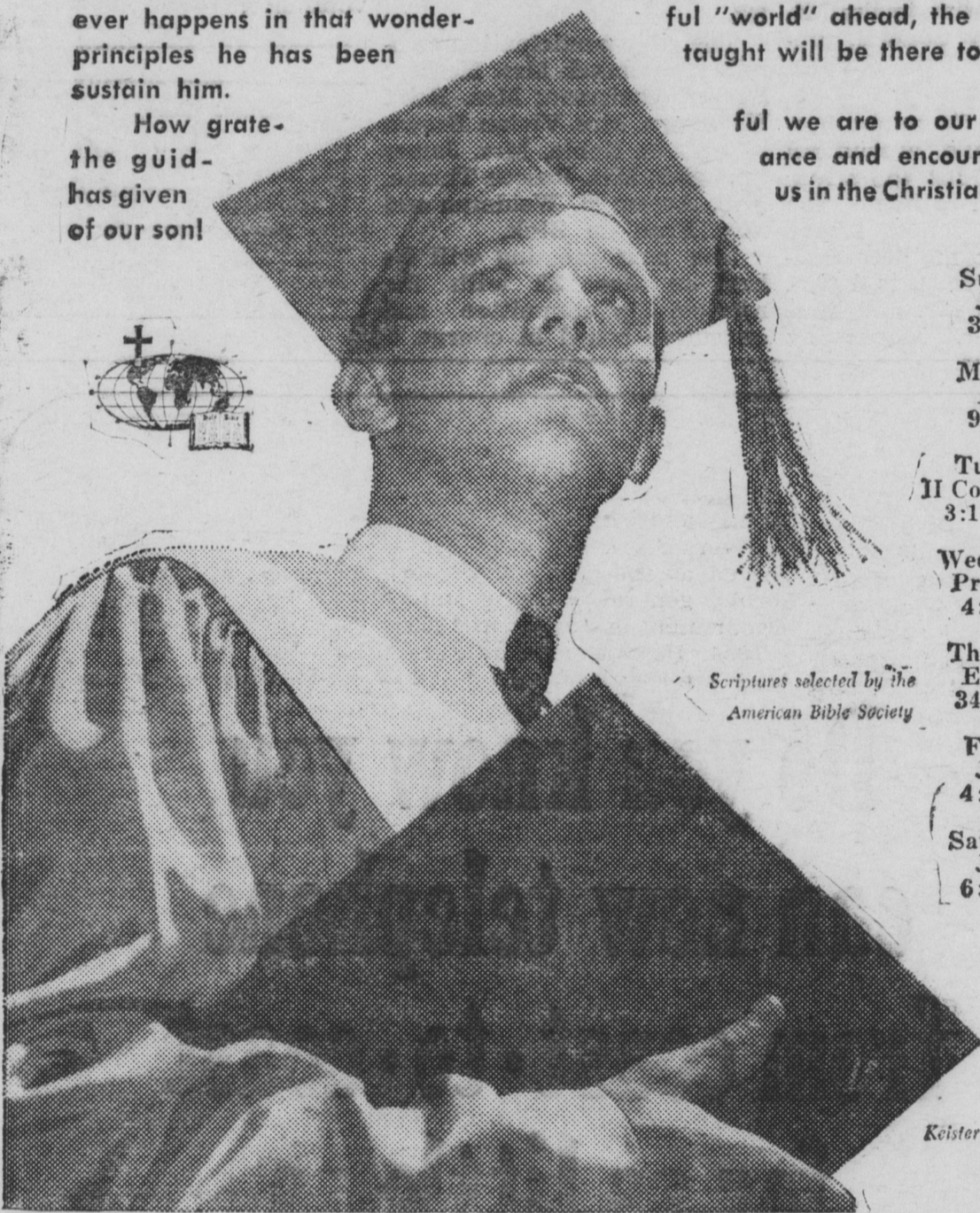
