**GRAPEFRUIT SHELL SALAD**  
3 grapefruit  
1 cup shredded raw carrots  
1 teaspoon celery seed  
1/2 cup sour dairy cream  
1 cup fresh dates  
1/2 medium-sized onion  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
Lettuce leaves  
Cut grapefruit into halves and remove sections to bowl. Remove all white membrane from shells, using scissors. Cut dates into wedges; slice onions into thin rings. Toss all ingredients together gently and spoon mixture into grapefruit shells. Top each with a dollop of sour cream and serve on crisp lettuce leaves. Serves six.
