noon.

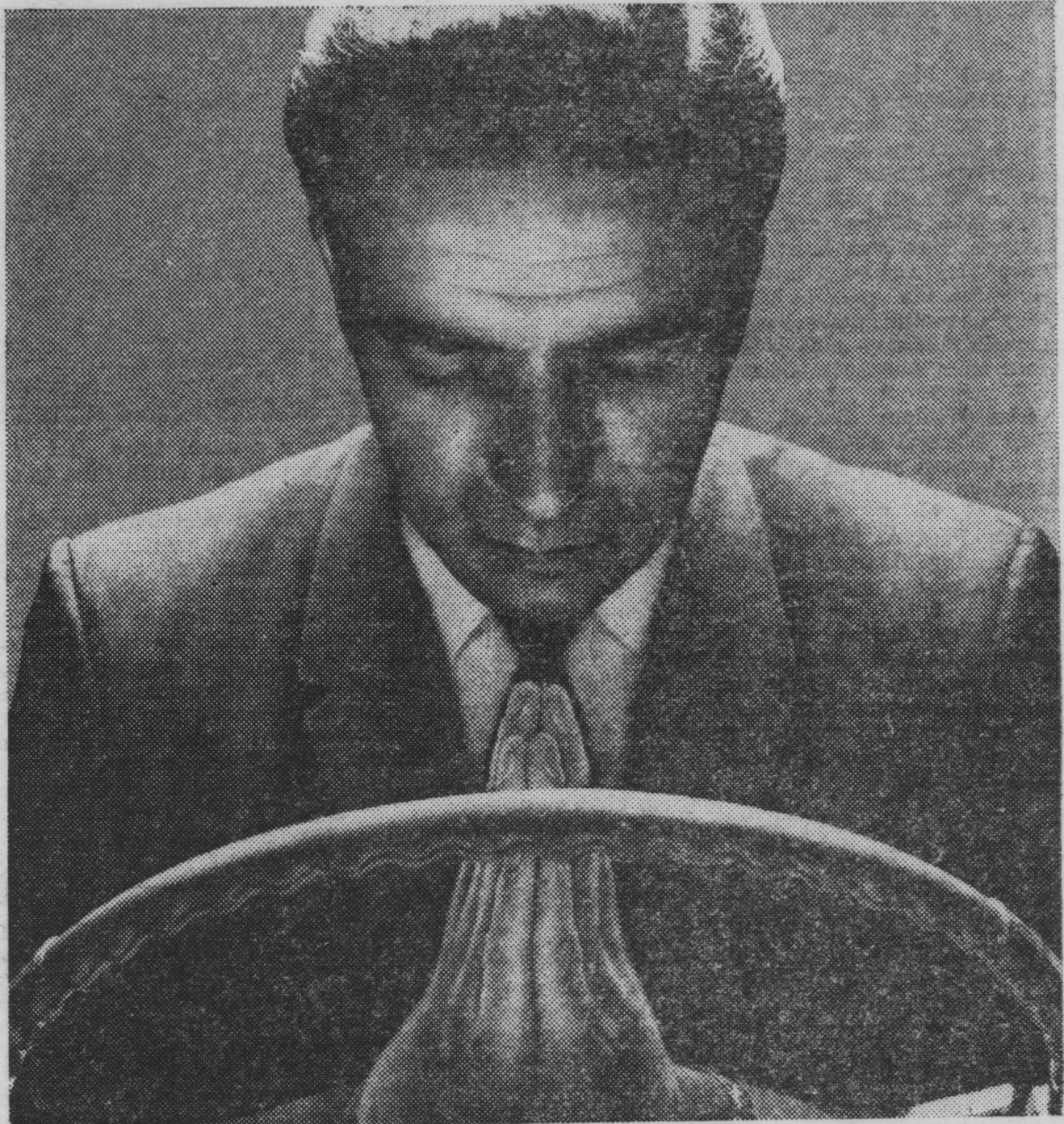
On Friday, Dec. 25, the entire office will be closed, so that all personnel may enjoy Christmas with their families.
