United to Buy

An agreement in principal for Poughkeepsie Rural Telephone Association of Poughkeepsie, Washington, to affiliate with the United Telephone System has been announced by Paul H. Henson, president of United Utilities, Incorporated, and O. E. Serwold, president of the Washington firm.

According to the proposal which is subject to execution of a definitive agreement and its approval by the Poughkeepsie stockholders and certain regulatory bodies, United Utilities would exchange 178,075 shares of its common stock for the assets of Poughkeepsie Rural Telephone Association. At a recent closing price on the New York Stock Exchange, the value of the United securities involved is approximately \$3.8 million.
