For up till that time, when army recruits were drafted, it was a "come as you are party."

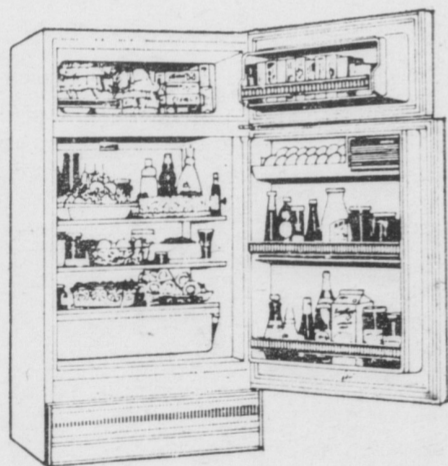
They brought their own varied weapons and were dressed in whatever clothing they happened to be wearing.

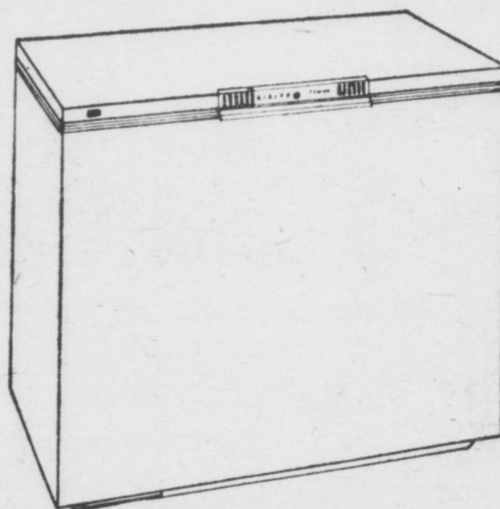

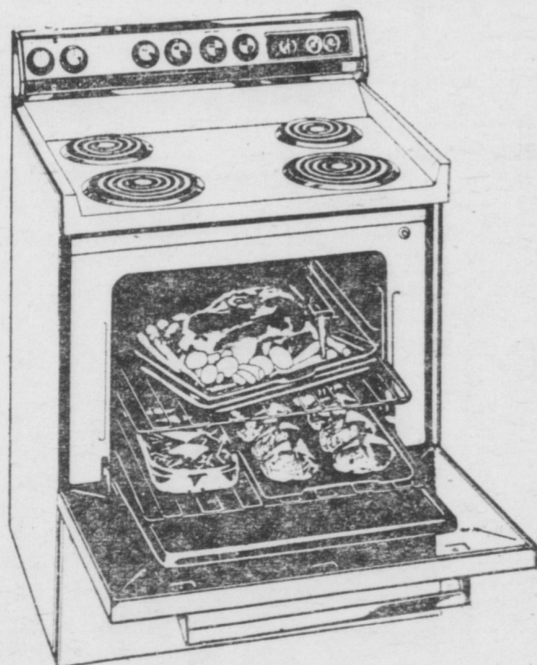

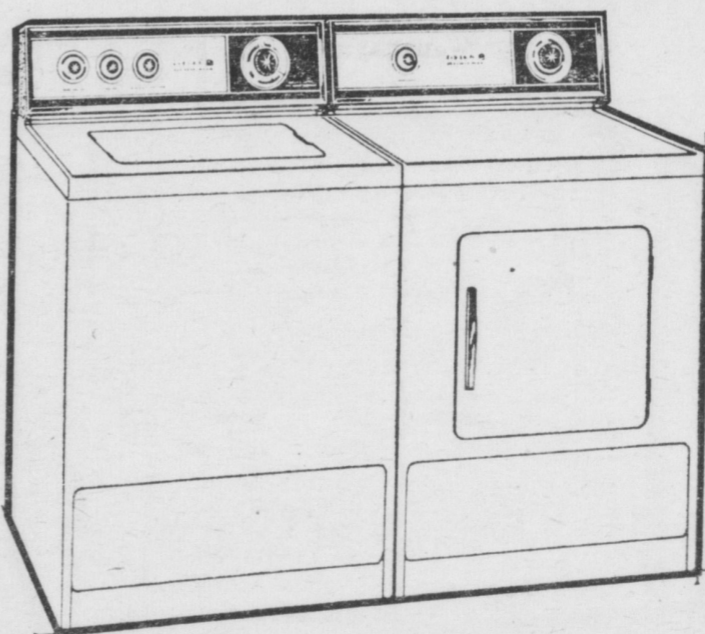
