When it comes to caring for polyesters, it's important to keep your eye on the temperature-of your iron, your washer and your automatic clothes dryer. Polyesters will glaze when the iron gets over 300 degrees Fahrenheit. And they'll wrinkle-set whenever the wash water or drying temperature gets too high.

So wherever heat and polyesters must mix, remember to keep the temperature as low as possible.

What To Do When Your Freezer Slops

The first thing to remember if your freezer stops running because of an electrical power failure it to keep it closed. How long the food in the freezer will stay frozen depends on the amount of food in the freezer. A full freezer will stay cold many hours longer than one that's only a quarter full.

If you can get dry ice. 25 pounds should hold the temperature of a half-full, 10 cubic foot freezer a bit below freezing for 2 to 3 days. Put heavy cardboard directly on the packages of frozen food and then put the dry ice on top of the cardboard.

You might consider covering the freezer with blankets, quilts, or some other covering. It will also help to put crumpled newspaper or excelsior between the cabinet and the blankets. But do not allow the coverings on the freezer to cover the air-vent opening. The power may go on unexpectedly and the unit will





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
