## Washing Electric Blankets

When using home laundry equipment to wash and dry electric blankets, follow instructions carefully. Every new electric blanket carries washing instructions. If you misplace the instructions, follow the following general washing Do not put electric bedding through a wringer because fine wires may be damaged. -Pretreat soiled binding or spots with a paste of detergent and water rubbed in with a brush. Disconnect removable electr- ned corn and season to taste ical parts. Tie any dangling with butter, salt and curry parts loosely in a washcloth powder.
