## IMPORTANT FOR WIFE TO KNOW FAMILY BUSINESS AFFAIRS

While no woman wants to consider the fact that she may become a widow, many financial advisers suggest that couples talk about such a possibility and about the husband's estate.

Every year, many new widows find they are completely ignorant of their husband's financial affairs. Extension home management specialists at Penn State university have some suggestions for husbands and wives who have delayed this discussion.

The most difficult part of the discussion is bringing up the subject. Once that is over, you should discuss each item thoroughly. And one of you should take notes as you go along.

Instructions to help the wife meet financial problems should include a listing of all life insurance policies, health and accidental death insurance, and employee group policies, as well as the name of the agent or agents involved. Keep this list in an accessible and, preferably, a fireproof place.

Along with the policies, all other assets such as cash, securities and personal possessions should be listed with

their approximate values. The location of all bank accounts and safe deposits should be noted. And the location of keys to deposit boxes should be mentioned.

A list of all current debts should be drawn up for the wife's benefit. Another list should include individuals owing the husband money

along with proof of their debts. The list should be updated periodically, remind Extension specialists.

You should discuss the location of property and other ownership records. The wife should also be informed of the location of the will. While a frantic and lengthy search for the whereabouts of the will has provided many a movie with thrills and excitement, it can cause only unneeded problems in real life.
