**Watchit, Driver
Potholes Ahead**

Motorists anxious to get out on the road now that warmer weather is on its way are reminded that while a robin may be the first sign of spring the roads you have to drive on are usually the last signs of winter.

Snow, ice, salt and sand take a great toll on streets & highways. Potholes are not only numerous and a driving nuisance, but also hazardous.

"Drivers should remember they can do a lot of damage to their cars and especially to their tires when hitting chuck holes in the road," says Ross R. Ormsby, Chairman of the Tire Industry Safety Council.

Obviously, a car striking a pothole, curb, or an object in the road can suffer damage not only to the tire and wheel assembly balance, but also to the vehicle's alignment.

Safety specialists say that if a driver notices an extreme wear pattern on the outside edges of his tires, or a veering of the car when the

brakes are applied, it is advisable he consult his dealer or garage about possible misalignment.

The damage resulting to a tire from sharply hitting holes in the road, curbs and general highway litter is often not visible. It could be internal and unrepairable. The driver might not know anything was wrong until the time he suffers sudden tire disablement, and that time is always the wrong time.
