Extension home management specialists at Penn State university say that one of benefits is that the working wife is increasing the overall financial security of her family. Even a slight increase in income often makes a big difference in the goods and services that a family can have.

Also, should an unforeseeable event reduce or eliminate the husband's income, the entire family income isn't lost. A wife who knows how to handle a job has valuable economic security in the event of premature death or disablement of her husband.

The working wife also increases her Social Security benefits. The benefits provided by Social Security become quite substantial for a woman after she has worked one and a half years. Or, if she is paying into some other kind of retirement plan, the working wife can add to the benefits she'll receive in later years.

A woman considering going to work should check on both pay and benefits to determine how much value they have for her, the Extension specialitst say. Most employers offer fringe benefits for their workers in the form of health, hospitalization and life insurance coverage. And a paid vacation is one of the most attractive hidden benefits for the working wife. Other benefits the
