Researchers have discovered that a well devised game can be the next best thing for recreating the excitement of actually "throwing the hat in the ring". One such game, de-veloped by 3M, involves participants in many of the pit-falls and challenges of a real political contest.

Realistically re-enacting the campaign events leading to a presidential election, the game is appropriately called, "Mr. President". Actual voting habits of the nation, based on statistics from past elections, are reflect-



ed as leaders are elected either by popular vote or electoral tal-The re-
