SPECIALIST GIVES SUGGESTIONS ON MEAL PLANNING FOR CHILDREN

Does the food you serve your child do more than just satisfy his hunger?? See that his meals furnish all the building materials needed for energy, growth, and health.

A child needs protein and minerals for growing, building and repairing body tissues, muscles and bones. Vitamins, together with minerals and protein, team up to keep the body in good running order. Fats and carbohydrates provide fuel for active play.

Because no one food can supply all the needed nutrients, include a wide variety of foods from the basic four food groups in your menus.

Give careful attention to flavor in a child's meal. Children have sensitive taste buds and prefer mild flavored vegetables, fruits, cheese & fish. You can adapt the family foods for very young children by using less spices and seasonings.

A child is fascinated with color and texture as well as flavor. Plan bright, colorful combinations of foods, and different textures for variety—chewy meats, crisp vegetables and fruits and smooth, soft puddings.

The way the food is cooked and served may also encourage your child to eat. When meat, fish and eggs are cooked at a low temperature, they will be more tender, moist & flavorful. Remove the bones and skin from your child's serving to eliminate the nuisance of picking them out himself.

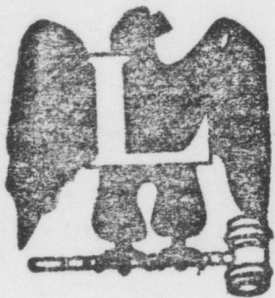

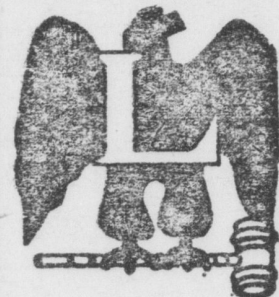
