BAKING TIP

To avoid "hot spots" inside your oven, place baking pans in the center of the oven. This will permit free circulation of air and heat on all sides and top and bottom. Extension foods and nutrition specialists at Penn State say when putting two or more pans in the oven at the same time, stagger them on different shelves, so that one is not directly above the other. There should be at least one inch between two pans on the same shelf.

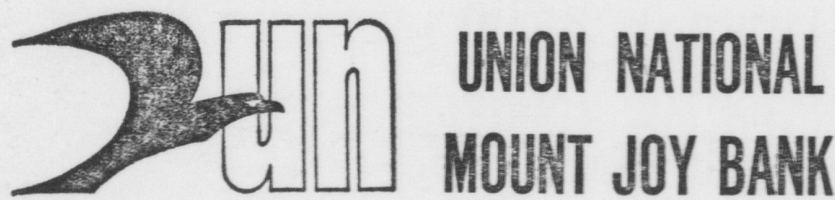
