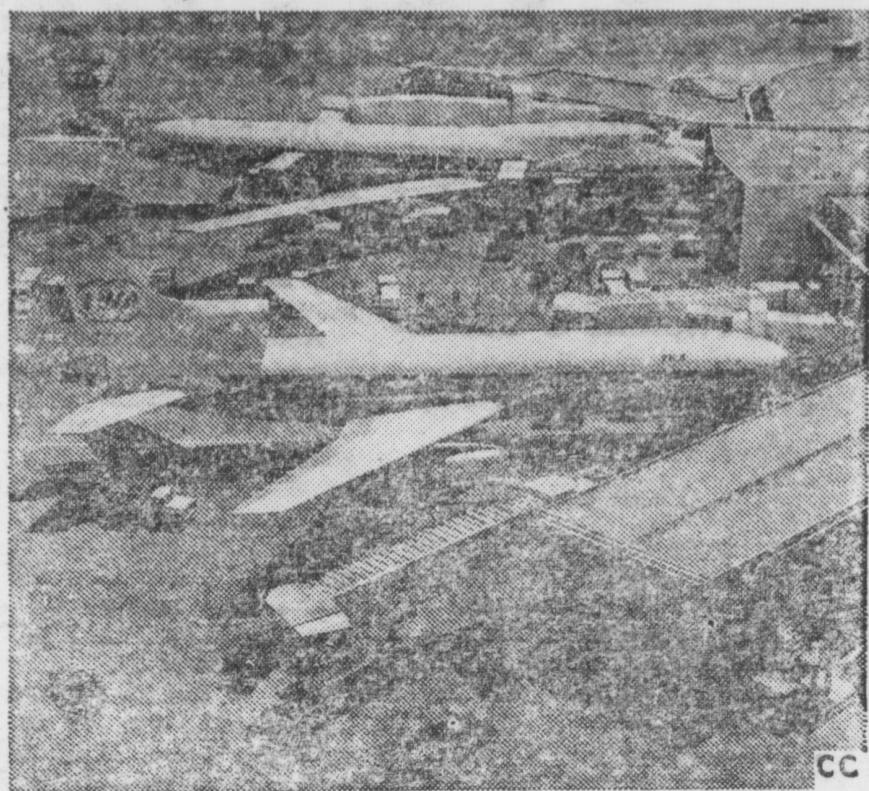
REBELS STOPPED

BIG, CLEAN, QUIET



Although the Boeing 747 (top) ushered in the age of virtually smoke-free and quieter engines, the new L-1011 (bottom) goes a step better. Although each of the L-1011's three engines generates 42,000 pounds of thrust at take-off, it is the quietest commercial jet flying. Engine smoke? There's practically none. The scene is Los Angeles International Airport.

"Airplanes have always been built for efficiency and passenger comfort," a Trans World Airlines executive said recently. "Now, environmental acceptability is another major factor and we have an airplane that is nearly perfect. It's the L-1011."

The airline industry has been one of the most responsive when it comes to improving technological and environmental harmony. The carriers have spent millions of dollars re-fitting their older jet engines with special smoke-reduction devices.

Smoke emission from the new TWA L-1011 is practically non-existent.

Powered by three Rolls-Royce engines, the L-1011 is 60 to 75 percent less annoying to the human ear around airports than the more familiar four-engine, narrow body-jets. The Federal Aviation Administration lists three noise level criteria for new jet aircraft, and the L-1011 is quieter on all three counts, according

to TWA.

TWA introduced the big plane as part of its expanding Ambassador Service fleet—airplanes furnished for "top of the line" service. Inside the L-1011, passengers will find aisles on both sides of the plane, lounges in coach and first class, carry-on baggage compartments and two-and-two coach seating. First class seats swivel to form foursomes for cocktails, cards or dinner. They won't find the kitchen; it's downstairs.

TWA Captain J. E. Frankum, vice president—flight operations, said the "L-1011 is the only airplane flying in the U.S. equipped to land when weather conditions force other planes to hold or divert to another airport."
