### HELP PRESCHOOLERS DEVELOP INTEREST IN READING

The most natural, healthful way to interest your child in books is to read to him, says James Van Horn, Extension family life specialist at Penn State.

Sometimes parents force the use of devices that have the opposite effect when they try to capture their attention to teach him to read. For example, aids such as flash cards & alphabet blocks may help develop some skills, but forcing them upon a child may develop a hostile resistance to books.

Van Horn advises reading

to your child as soon as he is old enough to sit still and listen. He may not even be old enough to understand all the words, but he will still enjoy being with you, hearing the sound of your voice and watching your facial expressions.

Sitting so your child can see the pages helps him to correlate the written and spoken word. Books with pictures help him relate to the story. And as he continues to develop, he will be able to "read" with you.

Reading to your child should not stop when he begins kindergarten. Instead, you should continue reading to him with expression. Van Horn says that reading with expression not only makes the story more interesting but also helps a child learn the meaning of punctuation marks.

### IDENTIFY
