NEW PROCESS WOOL FABRIS
Home seamstresses who find the process of shrinking woolens before sewing a nuisance, will soon find that problem eliminated.
Mrs. Ruth Ann Wilson, Extension clothing specialist at Penn State, reports that the textile industry has developed a process to stabilize wool and
wool-blend fabrics to a residual shrinkage of $1 / 2$ to $1 \%$. The traditional cold-water shrinking and steam-sponging techniques usually applied to woolens and worsteds result in a possible 3 to 4 percen shrinkage.
