Boro Completes 1973 Summer **Street Projects**

For all practical purposes, the 1973 Mount Joy street program has been completed.

At a couple of spots -- like a north Market Avenue and Church Street -- there is some remaining work, but the bulk of the program has been completed by two different contractors.

The summer projects will cost the borough a little more than \$30,000, which is about the amount which is spent each season on such improvements.

The B.R. Kreider company did work contracted at \$11,860 and H.R. Martin performed \$18,538 on contract.

A little more work had been but engineering planned, problems arose and some have nor yet been solved. They probably will be carried over until 1974.
