**P.P. & L. Dividend Moves Up 2 Cents**

An increase in the quarterly dividend rate to 45 cents per share, from 42 cents per share, on its common stock has been announced by Pennsylvania Power & Light Company's board of directors. The higher dividend, which will be payable on July 1, to shareowners of record June 10, is the first increase by the company since 1972.

In other board action, it was announced that company earnings for the 12

months ended April 30 were \$2.59 per share compared to \$2.49 per share for the same period last year.

In commenting on the increase in the dividend rate, Jack K. Busby, PP&L president, said, "This modest increase conforms with company policy which, in turn, is consistent with the industry norm. It does nothing more than keep pace with the increased per share investment by our shareowners."
