Moderator to Talk Sunday at Florin Church of Brethren

Dr. Wayne F. Geisert, 1974 Annual Conference Moderator of the Church of the Brethren, will speak in a pre-Conference inspirational service in the Florin Church of the Brethren on Sunday evening, June 16, at 7:30 p.m.

Dr. Geisert, reared on a farm near Abilene, Kansas, is president of Bridgewater College (Va.) and is only the third layman ever to hold the highest elective office in the denomination.

As an educator, Geisert taught at Northwestern

University, was professor of economics at Manchester College (Ind.), and was Dean of McPherson College (Kan.) before accepting the presidency of Bridgewater College in 1964. He received the B.A. degree from McPherson College and the Ph.D. in Economics from Northwestern. During World War II he served as an officer in the U. S. Naval Reserves in the Pacific area.

His rare appearance on Sunday evening in the Florin church will climax a busy day of appearances in Lancaster county. Sunday evening, his message will be "Neighbors or Numbers". Congregational singing and special music will augment the service.
