Robert Pekarek of Mount Joy will be among the participants in the 29th annual U.S. Junior Open Chess tournament, scheduled at Franklin and Marshall College August 5-9.

Pekarek, a student at W.I. Beahim junior high school, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. James Pekarek Donegal Springs Road.

More than 200 junior chess players are expected to compete in the five-day event sanctioned by the U.S. Chess Federation. This is the first time in five years that the U.S. Junior Open has been held on the East Coast.
