Eater, a lifelong resident of Marietta, has been road supervisor for East Donegal Twp. for 20 years but retired a number of years ago.

Later, he was employed at Wyeth Laboratories in Marietta for nine years. He was a member of St. John's Episcopal Church of Marietta and the Marietta Beneficial Association.

He was the son of the late George and Ellen Eater and the last surviving member of his immediate family.

Services were held from the Smedley funeral home, Marietta, Thursday afternoon, Sept. 19, and burial was made the Marrietta cemetery.


Services were held Thursday morning, Sept. 19, from the Heilig funeral home and burial was made in the Millersville Mennonite cemetery.
