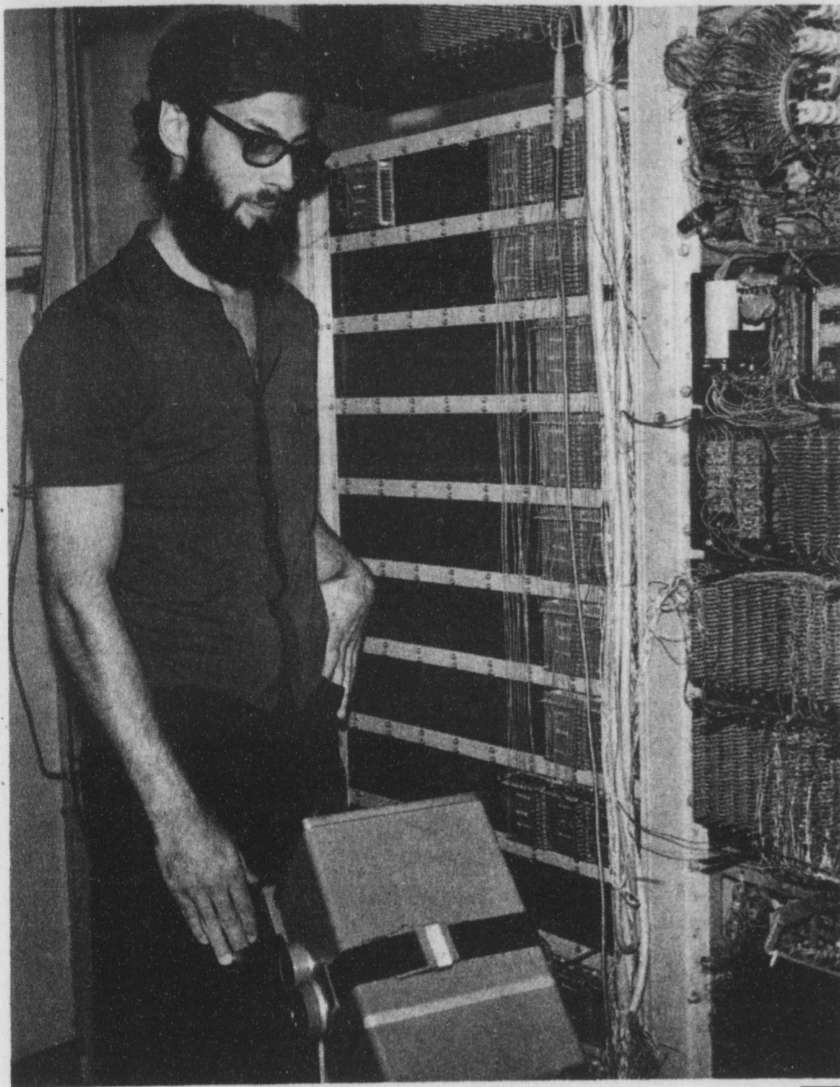


Steve Flick Completes Course
