

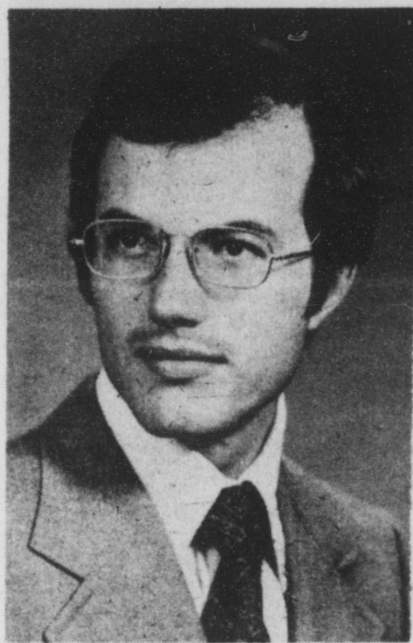
Pick Mount Joy Man EMC College Trustee
