During eighth, ninth and tenth grade she was a member of the Lancaster Youth Symphony.

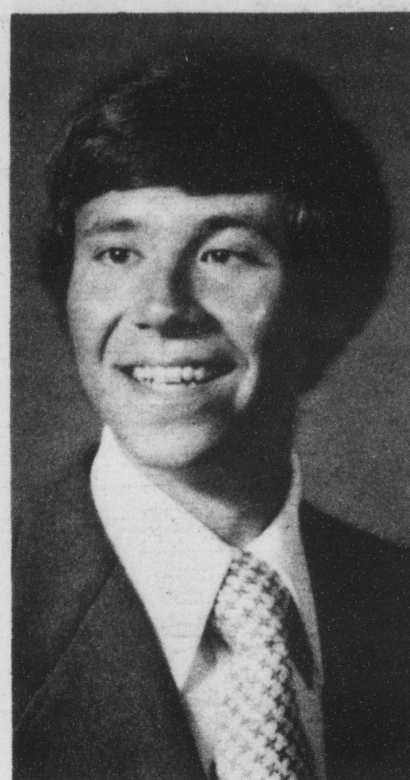
She is a member of the Hill United Church of Christ of Cleona, where she is president of the Youth Fellowship.
