Section 66. Coin Deposit in Meters. Upon parking any vehicle in a parking meter zone at any time during which the parking limit provisions of this ordinance are in effect, the operator thereof shall, upon entering the designated parking space, immediately deposit or cause to be deposited a five cent coin or coins or a ten cent coin of the United States in the designated slot of the parking meter controlling such parking space, and, on a manually operated parking meter, operate it in accordance with the directions thereon. Upon the deposit of such coin or coins and the placing of the said meter in operation, such parking space may be lawfully occupied by any vehicle during the period of

time as indicated on the parking meter. If a vehicle remains in a parking space for such a length of time that the meter shall indicate that the lawful parking period has expired, such vehicle shall be considered as parked overtime, and in violation of this ordinance. The coins deposited shall

permit the legal parking of a vehicle in a parking zone at the following rates:

a. Each nickel (\$.05) will provide 30 minutes of parking time when deposited up to the maximum time indicated on the meter.

b. Each dime (\$.10) will provide one hour of parking time when deposited up to the maximum time indicated on the meter.


