

The Bulletin basketball statistical analysis



The Donegal Indians Basketball Team after getting off to a dismal start, which saw them winning but 3 of their first 10 games, have finally put it together. The Indians, under head coach, Emil Swift, have now won 9 of their first 10 games. That one loss, incidentally, was a one-pointer in the last 15 seconds to league leading Garden Spot (11-1). Donegal's league record stands at 9 wins-against 3 losses and coming into the final week of the regular basketball season, the Indians must hope for a minor miracle, if they are to have a shot at the Section III Title. However, should Annville-Cleona upset Garden Spot in a game played at Annville this Tuesday evening and should Donegal also upend the Spartans in the seasons finale at Donegal on Friday night; there would then be a four way tie for first place in Section III with Garden Spot, Annville-Cleona, Lebanon Catholic and Donegal all having identical records of 11 wins and 3 losses.

Donegal Indians Basketball Team, having scored 1,490 points in their first 20 games, are the highest scoring team in the Lanco-Lebanon Basketball League. They have scored 149 points more than their nearest competitor, (Garden Spot) for an average of 74.5 points per game.
