## PP&L operated for three months with only 1,900 people. Does this mean you're greatly overstaffed?



## ANSWER

Normally we work a 40-hour week, but during the strike a smaller group was working 72 hours a week and more. Also, you must take into account the important construction and maintenance work that simply could not be done. But most noticeable, and most annoying to customers, was the absence of hundreds of meter readers which made it necessary to estimate service bills. In any case, recognizing the problems of our industry we're taking a long hard look at our present operation and our plans for the future. As a result, we have eliminated or delayed some of our construction projects resulting in some employees being laid off. Also, retiring employees will not automatically be replaced. Beyond that we'll be examining closely all our operations including manpower and make whatever changes are necessary for maximum efficiency.
