The boat shuttled between Marietta and Accomac on weekends and holidays on a regular schedule and was removed from the water onto a rack for the winter months.


"Accomac?"



In 1973 Hoffman was elected President and Director of the Bank.


He was graduated from East Donegal Township High School and Messiah College. He has also studied with the American Institute of Banking.
